

FACT SHEET: CHT AGED CARE FUND



We offer continuing and respite care in quality rest home, hospital and dementia care facilities staffed by dedicated, professional teams.

CHT's dedication to continuous quality improvement and innovation, and its desire to support delivery of high quality care across the entire aged care sector, has inspired it to establish the CHT Aged Care Fund. At the heart of the CHT organisation are the core values of care and compassion.

The purpose of the CHT Aged Care Fund is to enhance the wellbeing of older people by designating funds for the advancement of work among older people.

- The CHT Aged Care Fund will provide a selected number of grants each calendar year
- We are looking for applications in the following areas, directly relating to the aged care sector:
 - Research into the needs of older people
 - Improved access to care
 - Aged Care Workforce development
- We are looking for applications that demonstrate:
 - Quality and social benefit of outcomes 30%
 - Demonstrable benefit to aged care sector 15%
 - Capacity and capability to deliver 25%
 - Best Practice and sustainability of programmes (applied research) 15%
 - Alignment with CHT's Goals 15%
- The level of support each grant will provide will be based on the needs of the selected applications, which will require robust key performance indicators and reporting to ensure each grant is being used to maximum capacity and impact.
- In its first year up to \$200,000 will be designated for grants to be made to selected recipients whose applications are closely aligned to the purpose of the Aged Care Fund.
